Volunteer Guidelines

Recommended by the Board of Trustees

January 11, 2015

1. The church relies on a lot of volunteer effort which we greatly appreciate. However there have been things relocated, disposed of, changed, trimmed, etc. that creates extra work, expense, or heartache and discouragement to the volunteer efforts of others.
2. See something that needs attention? Check with the committee head in charge before you take on a job to make sure we're all acting as a team.
 - A. Don't know who's in charge? If you can't find them on the front of our phone directory, ask the pastor or the vice chairman of the board.
 - B. Even committee heads, the pastor, and the board have limited authority and may need to get the OK from others before a change can be made.
3. What if the committee head disagrees with you about what needs to be done or how to do it? Ask them about taking the disagreement to the next higher authority to resolve what should

be done.

In general check with the...

... Board before changing the look or functionality of any part of the building, including painting, changing light fixtures, etc.

... Building Manager before repair, replacing, removing modifying, or adding to the structure of the church buildings or doing non-routine cleaning. (For example: cleaning the inside of windows with ammonia-based cleaners or scrapers damages the window film.)

... Pastor before making any changes to the worship space, (especially chancel furnishings and decorations) bulletin boards and leaflet racks.

... Head of Women's Guild before reorganizing or throwing away chancel supplies, silk flowers, table decorations or kitchen goods.

... Grounds Manager before adding, removing, or trimming any plant material or landscape features.

... Appropriate Committee head before reorganizing or removing furnishings or storing things in spaces allotted to the Sunday School, Nursery, Library, Publication, BB Retreat, Book room, Social Committee, Sound System, etc.

... Pastor for anything else, such as borrowing tools, tables, chairs, etc. so that he can refer you to the person in charge, or so someone knows where things disappeared to.
