A Word for the Week:

The presence of the Lord involves freedom, the one following the other. The more present the Lord, the more free we are; that is, the more we are in the love of good and truth, the more freely we act. Such is the influx of the Lord through the angels. But on the other hand, the influx of hell through evil spirits is forcible, and impetuous, striving to dominate; for such spirits breathe

nothing but the utter subjugation of us, so that we may be nothing, and that they may be everything; and when they are everything we are one of them, and scarcely even that, for in their eyes we are a mere nobody. Therefore when the Lord is liberating us from their dominion and from their yoke there arises a combat; but when we have been liberated, that is, regenerated, we, through the ministry of angels, are led by the Lord so gently that there is nothing whatever of yoke or of dominion, for we are led by means of our delights and our happinesses, and are loved and esteemed.
